

ORDINANCE NO. 2837

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 2813 WHICH GRANTED TO ALBANY TRANSIT LINES THE PRIVILEGE OF OPERATING BUSES ON THE STREETS OF ALBANY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Albany Transit Lines has given formal notice to the City Council that it will terminate service on their bus routes within the City of Albany on the 31st day of March, 1959, and subsequent to that date, no further service is to be furnished to the people within the City of Albany on a route basis, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the people of the City of Albany that the right and privilege heretofore granted to Albany Transit Lines to operate a bus route over the streets of the City of Albany be terminated so that other service may be obtained and made available to the people of the City of Albany, now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY OREGON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: ORDINANCE REPEALED:

Ordinance No. 2813 and the whole thereof is hereby repealed.

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE:

WHEREAS, those benefits and privileges granted under Ordinance No. 2813 are to be terminated by the grantee and there will be no bus service available for the people of the City of Albany and it is in the best interest of the people of the City of Albany to obtain other bus service as soon as possible and the failure to have bus service is an emergency situation which must be remedied at the earliest possible time, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and it is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany that Ordinance No. 2813 be repealed, it is declared this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
