

ORDINANCE NO. 2871

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO DISPENSING WITH AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, UNDER 222.120 ORS REGARDING THE ANNEXATION OF LOTS 5, 6, 7 and 8, BLOCK 27, SOUTH ALBANY ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of October, 1959, there was filed with the City Recorder of the City of Albany, a petition and consent by the Petitioners, Rodney W. Tripp, Russell W. Tripp, Elwood A. McKnight and Suzanne R. McKnight, representing to be the owners of property contiguous to the City of Albany, Oregon, to elect to dispense with an election within the City of Albany concerning the annexation of said property and setting a date for the hearing of the same.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

That an election within the City of Albany regarding the annexation of the following described property to-wit:

Lot 5, 6, 7 and 9, Block 27, South Albany  
Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County,  
Oregon

be dispensed with.

Section 2: HEARING

That there shall be a Public Hearing as to the advisability of annexing the property described in Section 1 to the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 10th day of November, 1959, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to give Notice of said Public Hearing by publishing in a newspaper of general circulation published in the said City once (1) a week for two (2) successive weeks and by posting in four (4) public places a Notice setting forth the time and place of the said hearing and the description of the property to be considered for annexation and the purposes for which the hearing is held.

Section 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Whereas, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and should the same be annexed, that the City facilities be made available to this property, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
