

TITLE: An Ordinance vacating utility easements in a portion of Beams Supplemental Plat to Hollywood Acres, and Declaring an emergency.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany did by Resolution No. 1125 passed by the Council at the Council meeting on the 28th day of August, 1968, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. on the 9th day of October, 1968, as the time hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of utility easements between Lots 8 and 10, Block 4, Lots 7 and 9, Block 5, Lots 8 and 10, Block 5 and Lots 4 and 5, Block 6 on Beams Supplemental Plat to Hollywood Acres, Linn County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law in the said Resolution, and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on the 9th day of October, 1968, and no remonstrance was filed with the City Recorder, no persons appearing objecting to the proposed vacation of utility easements, now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

That the utility easements between Lots 8 and 10, Block 4, Lots 7 and 9, Block 5, Lots 8 and 10, Block 5 and Lots 4 and 5, Block 6 all in Beams Supplemental Plat to Hollywood Acres be and the same are hereby vacated as utility easements in the City of Albany.

Section 2:

Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
