

ORDINANCE NO. 3487

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE CREATING AN AMBULANCE FUND

RECITALS: WHEREAS, the City of Albany is undertaking the establishment and operation of a municipal ambulance, the use of which would generate revenues and create expenses and a separate fund should be established for the purpose of receiving monies generated from the ambulance service and for making expenditures incurred in the furnishing of ambulance service. Now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: FUND CREATED.

There is hereby created a fund which shall be known as the "City of Albany Ambulance Fund" for the purpose of depositing monies received from ambulance services furnished by the City of Albany and for making expenditures incidental to the operation of an ambulance service.

Section 2: The City Recorder is hereby directed to place all monies received from the furnishing of ambulance service by the City of Albany in the fund herein created and to make expenditures for expenses incidental to the furnishing of ambulance services from the fund herein created.
