

ORDINANCE NO. 4979

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING STATE TRAFFIC ACT AS AMENDED BY OREGON LAWS 1991 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Oregon Laws 1991 have amended the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Law of the State of Oregon which have heretofore been adopted by the City of Albany,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 13.04.080 of the Albany Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:


Section. 13.040.080 Adoption of Motor Vehicle Laws: Oregon Laws 1991. Violation of the provisions contained in Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapters, 801, 802, 803, 805, 806, 807, 809, 810, 811, 813, 814, 815, 816, 818, 819, 820, 821, 822, and 823 as amended by the Oregon Laws 1991 shall be an offense against the City of Albany and prosecution and trial thereunder shall be as provided therein.

Section 2: Emergency Clause. Inasmuch as the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany shall be affected by the adoption of the Oregon Motor Vehicle Laws, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
