

RESOLUTION NO. 45

WHEREAS, heretofore a petition was duly made and presented by the property owners, being more than two-thirds of the owners of the area of property surrounding a proposed street vacation; that the said street proposed to be vacated is described as follows, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, to-wit:

Maple Street from a point being the Northeast corner of Block 5, Schultz Front Addition, and running Southeast on a 58 foot radius curve, right a distance of 43 feet; thence continuing on a tangent to said curve 27 feet; thence south along the east line of Maple Street to 99-E; also from the above described initial point, south along the west line of Maple Street to 99-E.

It appears to the Council that no reason manifestly exists why said petition should not be allowed in whole or in part, and

THAT THE City Recorder shall forthwith give notice by publishing the notice in the Albany Democrat-Herald, a newspaper of daily circulation printed and published in Albany, Oregon, for four successive weeks, setting out the portion of the street sought to be vacated and showing the date of the petition as having been made on January 24, 1949, and

THAT said notice shall further be posted at or near each end of the proposed vacation and that such notice shall be headed "NOTICE OF STREET VACATION";

That the hearing on the petition shall be at the regular meeting of the Council and such meeting shall be designated as being the one at least twenty-eight days after the posting and publishing of the notice.
