


WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Council that the premises located at 623 South Jackson Street in Albany, Linn County, Oregon, are unsafe and that the building in question under construction thereon is reported to be a nuisance and the Construction Advisory Council of the City of Albany has recommended that condemnation proceedings be instituted against the structure, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to set a time and place for a public hearing to determine whether the said building is, in fact, a dangerous building, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany that a public hearing be held on the 23rd day of January, 1963, at the hour of 7:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers at the City Hall, City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, for the purpose of determining whether or not that structure located on the premises at 623 South Jackson Street in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, is a dangerous structure. Be it further

RESOLVED that the Council at said hearing determine whether or not said building is dangerous and that the owner or other persons interested in the said property be given notice of said hearing at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the hearing and that notices be posted in three (3) public places in the City of Albany setting forth the time and place and the purpose for which the said hearing shall be held.
