

(For Establishing Policy For Requesting Public Open Space In
Linn County Zoning Areas.)

WHEREAS, ORS Section 215.170 provides that a County Planning Commission shall have jurisdiction over all areas not within incorporated cities so far as control of subdivisions and renaming of thoroughfares at such time as the County Court shall have adopted a Subdivision Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, it has been the practice of the Planning & Zoning Commission of the City of Albany under the City of Albany Subdivision Ordinance to require dedication of public open space in all dedicated plats, and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the people of the City of Albany and the citizens of Linn County in the areas immediately adjoining the incorporated city limits of the City of Albany that subdivision plats should continue to have public open space for park purposes, and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Albany that it shall be the policy of the Planning and Zoning Commission to request the dedication of public open space on the basis as set forth in the City of Albany Subdivision Ordinance in all urban areas four or six miles adjacent to the City of Albany and particularly those areas under the jurisdiction of the County Planning Commission.


