

RESOLUTION NO. 2218

TITLE: RESOLUTION REQUIRING COUNCIL PERMISSION BEFORE THE
ISSUANCE OF A PARADE PERMIT.

WHEREAS, Section 13.32.010 of the Albany Municipal Code requires that a permit be issued for all parades, except funeral processions and parades of the military forces; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the people of the City of Albany that the Mayor, or his duly authorized representative, be given an opportunity to participate in any parade requiring the permit; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the City that the Council have knowledge and an opportunity to review all applications for a permit to conduct a parade within the City; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY that prior to the issuance of a permit by the Chief of Police of the City of Albany, the application with supporting materials shall be submitted to the City Council for review and comment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for all parades requiring a permit, the Mayor of the City of Albany, or his duly authorized representative, shall be invited to be a participant in the parade.
