
A RESOLUTION TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF GLULAM BEAMS FOR TWO PICNIC SHELTERS AT TIMBER LINN PARK.

WHEREAS, Albany Municipal Code exempts contracts from competitive bids if the board, by majority vote, determines the emergency condition requires prompt execution of the contract; and


WHEREAS, the Oregon Revised Statutes exempts contracts from competitive bidding if it is unlikely that such exemption will encourage favoritism in the awarding of public contracts or substantially diminish competition for public contracts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council adopts the findings and waives the requirement for competitive bidding for the purchase of glulam beams for the picnic shelters at Timber Linn Park.

As you know, we are moving forward immediately to construct two new picnic shelters at Timber Linn Park. There is one additional purchase that needs to be made that will cost more than \$5,000 which is the formal bid limit. This purchase is the glulam beams for the support of the roofs of the shelters. We have received four written quotations which are listed below.

1.	Copeland Lumber	\$7,170.84
2.	Scharfs Twin Oaks	7,058.12
3.	Ace Home Center	7,557.96
4.	Random Pacific	7,652.80

It is requested that the City Council waive the formal bid process and award the low bid to Scharfs Twin Oaks.
