

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ALBANY TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION FOR 2ND AVENUE CREEK RESTORATION FROM OREGON WATERSHED ENHANCEMENT BOARD (OWEB) GRANT FUNDS AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH AND FUND THE REST OF THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board (OWEB) has invited applicants to apply for grants for watershed restoration, assessment, education, and monitoring projects; and


WHEREAS, a local match of at least 25 percent is required; and

WHEREAS, a receipt of these funds will allow the City to maximize stream restoration efforts while addressing the failing 2nd Avenue culvert at Periwinkle Creek; and

WHEREAS, this OWEB grant application will request approximately \$100,000 for stream restoration and the local match will be approximately \$279,000, which will come from a Capital Improvement Project funded from 03-410 Street Capital.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany approves and endorses the submittal of a grant application to OWEB for the purpose of removing the failing 2nd Avenue culvert and restoring Periwinkle Creek in the vicinity.
