



RESOLUTION NO. 6987

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ALBANY TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FUNDS AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, the City of Albany is eligible to receive Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) grant funds; and

WHEREAS, approval of the FAA is required in order to expend these funds on capital projects for the benefit of the Albany Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, receipt of these funds will allow for construction of an Automated Weather Observation System to be completed at the Albany Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, total project cost will be approximately \$513,600; and

WHEREAS, a 10 percent match is required for FAA grant funds; and


WHEREAS, the City of Albany's local match will be approximately \$51,360; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 6970, the City of Albany secured funding in the amount of \$35,500 to pay for a portion of the required 10 percent local match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council approves and endorses the submittal of a grant application to the Federal Aviation Administration for the purpose of constructing an Automated Weather Observation System at the Albany Municipal Airport.


