

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT (VOCA) GRANT AND CRIMINAL FINE ACCOUNTS (CFA) GRANT FROM THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Justice has offered Albany a VOCA grant in the amount of \$127,720 and a CFA grant in the amount of \$62,829.15 to continue the victims' assistance program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany supports the continuation of a municipal victims' assistance program that provides aid to victims of crime; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used for staffing the victims' assistance program to provide guidance to victims and reduce the impact of crime on victims' lives.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that the City of Albany accepts the VOCA grant in the amount of \$127,720 and the CFA grant in the amount of \$62,829.15 for the purpose of continuing and staffing the victims' assistance program; and authorizes the police chief to execute the agreements and conditions for its acceptance.
