Refund Policy: Our mission is to provide quality recreational experiences that are financially sustainable. Activities, programs, and classes must meet minimum enrollments in order to be offered. If Parks & Recreation for any reason cancels an activity, program, or class a full refund will be issued.

- Classes & Programs: A participant can receive a full refund, less a \$5 processing fee if they notify Parks & Recreation five business days prior to the start of the class. After five days, a credit will be given. If a program is less than \$15 only a credit will be given if participant cancels.


