



**DAYS OF OPERATION** Monday–Friday

NO SERVICE DAYS on all City-observed holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, Memorial Day, Juneteenth, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving and the day after, and Christmas.

**BICYCLES** All buses are equipped with bicycle racks that hold two bikes. Access is first come, first served. We cannot accommodate motorized, oversized, or any bicycle that will not fit on the bicycle rack. Bikes are not allowed on-board. Bike lockers are available to rent.
