- b. Roundtable Discussion of Community Traffic Safety Issues/Concerns
- First and Lyon project timing/funding – Irish explained that ODOT has not committed funds to this project, even though Lyon is part of the state highway system. This puts the City in a position of looking for funding sources. He does not know what year of the new CIP will include this project.
 - Airport Road north bound/left turn to Killdeer – Drivers cannot legally turn left there because of the pavement markings.
 - Pedestrian-activated crossing on Pacific between Waverly and Burkart – Irish said ODOT may be interested in this as part of their Safe Routes to School commitment because Waverly and South Shore elementary schools are both within one-half mile of this area. It was suggested that placement of these should also be coordinated with possible future bus stops.

Streitberger said it is possible Tadena and Central schools will be merged. There needs to be discussion about traffic consequences of that merge. Discussion ensued.
