Call to Order Vice chair Ray Kopczynski called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m.

Roll Call

Approval of Minutes

MOTION: Jackie Montague moved to approve the January 27, 2022, minutes as written; Cowan seconded; and it passed unanimously.

Election of Officers

MOTION: Kopczynski moved to appoint Montague as chair, Scott Cowan seconded the motion, and it was approved unanimously. Montague moved to appoint Cowan as vice chair, Montague seconded the motion, and the motion was approved unanimously.

Introductions Albany Operations Manager Kristin Preston introduced herself and City of Albany staff, titles, and roles. Preston discussed the purpose of the committee and discussed the different facilities.

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Facility Updates

Preston introduced Albany Water Superintendent Scott LaRoque, who presented an overview of the water treatment plants, including production, age, equipment, and operation.*

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Upcoming Project, Budget

LaRoque provided project updates on the following projects: membrane replacement, raw water generator, AM reservoir discharge valve replacement, raw water inlet valve replacement, treatment plant generator, and the water master plan update.

In response to a question from Cowan regarding the generator, LaRoque explained the number of power outages in the last year and the reasons we should purchase a generator instead of contracting for one. In addition, LaRoque explained the importance of testing the generators throughout the year.

LaRoque provided an overview of the current water treatment budget, including reduction in power costs, doubling chemical costs, and staffing allocations.

Regulatory Updates

LaRoque discussed having an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) audit recently. The EPA started a new compliance initiative, and the City of Albany was selected for the audit. The cities of Dallas and Corvallis were also selected for the audit. In addition, LaRoque provided an update on ongoing PFAS sampling.

Facility Updates

Albany Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) Supervisor Brian Stevens presented background information for the WRF, including design capacity, the 2009 construction, and performance testing for solid composting. In addition, Stevens provided background information on the Talking Water Gardens (TWG), including the 2011 construction completion, wetland studies, and the 2021 Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) Mutual Agreement and Order.

Compost Facility Next Steps

Stevens provided information and an update regarding the status of the compost facility. Stevens discussed the different testing requirements and noted that the performance testing is complete. Compost is currently being used by Park Maintenance within the City. Albany Wastewater Superintendent Craig Prosser discussed the next steps for the compost facility, including external partners/users, public engagement, and expanding the facility.

Upcoming Projects, Budget

Stevens discussed the upcoming WRF projects: hypochlorite system improvements, screen inspection/modification, fire panel replacement, grit system improvements, and transformer service.

Stevens provided information regarding the WRF budget, including increase explanations, chemical costs, and energy savings.

Regulatory Updates

Prosser discussed regulatory updates, which included the NPDES permit renewal status that is expected to be issued early 2024 and the TWG mutual agreement and order status extended to July 2023.
